

Our 21st Annual Parade of Rescued Siberians will be held on Friday October 27th in the afternoon (time to be announced)

The Parade of rescue is a way to honor those that have "rescued a Siberian or husky". They can be rescued from a shelter, the freeway, another person and many other ways. Some are young, some are old, some have had horrific injuries and some are just typical huskies.....all rescued and loved now in a new home. They can be represented in person or by a picture (it isn't easy for some of them to come to the nationals). Some dogs that have gone to the rainbow bridge are also represented.

The Parade is free to those that participate. We create a Rescue Catalog and list all the dogs, their bios and a picture, for all to read their wonderful stories. All participants receive a large Rosette with their name on it, a bag of "goodies" for the dog and the owner as a thank you for taking these dogs into their homes.

At the parade we read your dog's bio as you walk around the ring with your dog (or your dog's picture). We go from the youngest to the oldest. At the end we do a group picture of all of those that participated. There are not many times that we can say thank you to those that have rescued.
